GRADES AND VALUES

Final grades are reported for each student for every course undertaken according to the following grading system:

| GRADE | Grade Score | INTERPRETATION | GRADE POINT VALUE |
|------------|-------------|-------------------|-------------------|
| A | 90 - 100 | Excellent | 4 Points |
| B | 80 - 89 | Good | 3 Points |
| C | 70 - 79 | Average | 2 Points |
| D | 60 - 69 | Poor | 1 Point |
| CR | - | Equivalent | Not Computed |
| F | Below 60 | Failing | 0 points |
| I | - | Incomplete | Not Computed |
| W | - | Withdrawn | Not Computed |
| P/SA/SB/SC | - | Pass/Satisfactory | Not computed |

To receive credit for a course, a student must earn a semester grade of not less than "D" or "CR."
