

STUDENT POLICIES

SETTLEMENT OF OBLIGATIONS

- Payment deadlines are posted in the academic calendar.
- Payment or payment arrangements not received by payment deadlines will result in the student being dropped for non-payment.
- Students who fail to settle their financial obligations to the college, or establish satisfactory payment arrangements, risk the withholding of course credits and grades. Furthermore, unpaid balances will be forwarded to a collection agency 90 days following the conclusion of the term.
- Students will not be allowed to register for classes with an outstanding financial obligation.
- No degree or certificate will be awarded until all financial obligations are settled.
- The term "financial obligations" shall include the return of all properties of the college on student assignment including library books.
